



## Internet Policy – Student Use and Access Agreement

Using computers, the Internet and the resources they offer is an important part of learning. It provides opportunities to learn but also contains responsibilities for the student.

As students of Panmure Primary School we want to have access to the Internet for our project work. We support the rules for the safe use and access of the Internet. All pupils should know the expectations in using this equipment and abide by the rules.

We understand that breaking any of the rules listed below could lead to an immediate ban from the use of computers and/or the Internet.

1. I agree to follow all teacher instructions regarding the use and activities on computers.
2. I will take care of and show respect for the computer hardware and software including the use of the Internet.
3. I will not wilfully interfere with or alter any software installed on the computers.
4. I will only use the cached access to the Internet as provided by the school.
5. If I access the World Wide Web I will do so only under the supervision of my teacher.
6. I will respect the e-mail privacy of my fellow students.
7. I will not send any offensive or inappropriate e-mail.
8. I will not divulge any personal or private information on the Internet.
9. I will not publish any work on the WWW without the permission of my teacher.

**I agree to follow these rules and am aware that breaking them will have the following consequences:**

1. Misuse of the Internet will lead to an immediate ban from use.
2. Deliberate misuse of a computer system causing damage will result in my parents being contacted and responsible for any restitution of the damage caused by deliberate misuse.
